We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord, God, heavenly king, O God, Almighty Father.





Refrain: Beyond the moon and stars, as deep as night, so great our hunger Lord, to see your light.


The sparrow finds her home beneath your wing.

- 3. Upon our darkness, Lord....., a light has shone. You chose to dwell with us...... in flesh and bone.


