Lord, God, heavenly king, O God, Almighty Father.

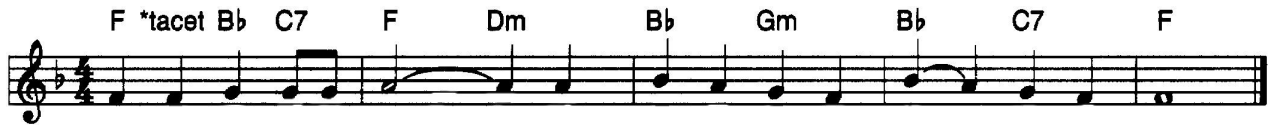
Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son,

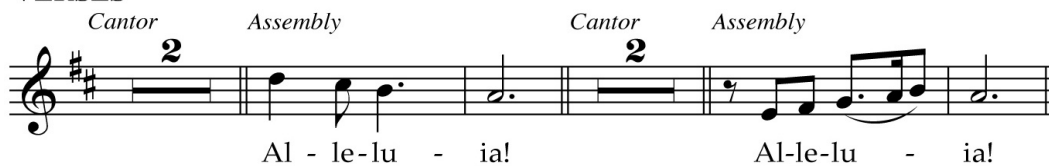
