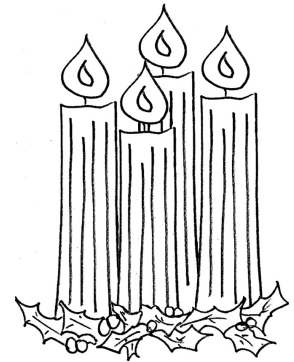
1. O Come, O Come Emmanuel and ransom captive Israel.

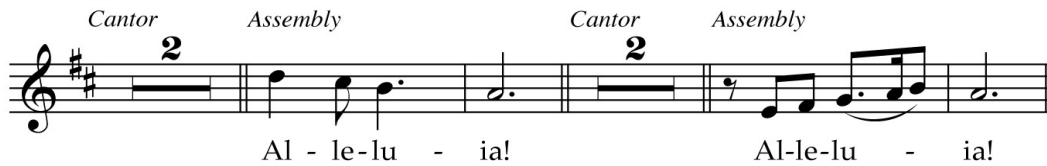
